

Peer Selection Process

Staff Considerations:

- Was the candidate on time?
- Was the candidate able to share personal experiences during interview?
- Was the candidate able to communicate effectively?
- How did references perceive candidate?
- Does the candidate have the ability & resources to take on role?
- Can candidate work well with others?

Peer Considerations:

- Is this a good fit for me?
- Will earning wages decrease my current benefits? Was I able to communicate effectively?
- Do I have transportation to fulfill this commitment?
- Can I work with my peers without being judgmental?
- Can I avoid inflicting my own personal & religious views?
- Can I maintain confidentiality?
- How will this affect my overall well-being/health?
